In terms of the compromise the petitioner, who is present in person states that he will withdraw the the Criminal Revision No. 292 of 2014 pending before this Court for 16.10.2015 and the appeal No. 159 of 2011 pending before the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission. The respondents on their part will withdraw the civil suit instituted by them against the petitioner and others. In terms of the order dated 17.9.2015, the respondents have handed over two drafts drawn in the names of the persons whom the petitioner himself wanted for Rs. 3.75 lakh each and had also received the draft on his own behalf for the sum mentioned in the order dated 17.9.2015.

2. The revision petition is disposed of in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties.
