There is delay of 78 days in re-filing and 158 days in filing the present revision petition.

For the reasons mentioned in the applications supported by affidavits, delay of 78 days in re-filing and 158 days in filing the present revision petition is condoned, subject to all just exception.

Applications stand disposed of.

Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 31.07.2014 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Addl. District Judge, Ludhiana, vide which the execution application filed by the petitioner under Order XXI, Rule 11(2) CPC was dismissed.

The execution application of the present petitioner was dismissed *inter alia* on the ground that the decree holder could not file the list of the properties of the judgment debtors, nor furnish the correct addresses of judgment debtors in spite of repeated efforts.

In case of execution, the decree holder may file the fresh execution whenever he gets the correct address and the details of the properties of the judgment debtors, subject to the law of limitation.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is dismissed.
