1. 5th respondent served through wife. Service deemed sufficient.

2. The application is filed by the defendant to have the signature/thumb-impression of the plaintiff to be examined through the hand-writing and finger print expert. The plaintiff has expired and the application is moved by the legal representative. The court has observed that it would be in the interest of justice to allow the application so that the real controversy between the parties could be adjudicated upon. It is also observed that no prejudice would be caused if the application is allowed. The court also observed that the plaintiff would be given an opportunity to cross-examine the expert witness and hence, allowed the petition. I find no reason for interference in the exercise of discretion made by the trial Court which is appropriate and proper. The civil revision is dismissed.
