ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the sole petitioner Kartar Singh has since passed away but neither his LRs nor anybody on his behalf has contacted his office in the recent past. He submits that although he does not have any concrete instructions, but even the demised premises had since fallen down.

That being so, it is submitted that let the petition be disposed of as having become infructuous. However, if any, dispute, interest or cause of action still survives, petitioner or his LRs shall be at liberty to move the necessary application for restoration of the petition, for decision on merits.
