Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 27.05.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, whereby evidence of defendant No.4-petitioner has been closed by order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the suit filed by Surjit Kaur-respondent No.4 for declaration that she is entitled to pensionary benefits of late Labh Singh, defendant Nos. 1 to 3 had closed their evidence on 27.04.2015 and thereafter, the present petitioner (defendant No.4) was given only two effective opportunities to lead her evidence on 11.05.2015 and 27.05.2015. However, on 27.05.2015 her evidence was closed by order. He further states that at present, the petitioner is receiving the pensionary benefits of late Labh Singh.

In the given circumstances of the case, to impart complete justice to the parties and also to avoid deprivation of full opportunity to the petitioner, this Court deems it appropriate to provide some time to the petitioner to complete her evidence.

In view of the above, the impugned order dated 27.05.2015

(Annexure P-3) is set aside and one effective opportunity is granted to the

petitioner to conclude her evidence, subject to costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Service Authority.

Allowed accordingly.
