Counsel for the petitioner states that this petition may be dismissed as withdrawn but urges that any observations made in the impugned order may not stand in the way of adjudication of substantive rights of the parties and some time limit should be fixed for disposal of the suit and stay order granted vide order dated 02.09.2008 may be continued till disposal of the suit .

In view of the above submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a direction to the trial court to dispose of the main suit within six months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and in the meantime the stay order order dated 02.09.2008 shall remain operative. It is made clear that the observations made in the impugned order would not stand in the way of the parties at the time of adjudication of their substantive rights.

The Trial Court shall give three opportunities to each of the parties for concluding their evidence even by adjourning the case on day-to-day basis.
