K.Kannan, J.

There is no justification for the petitioners to arrive in revision before this Court, if the Court below had closed the evidence on his failure to turn up in Court. The only remedy will be to approach the very same Court and seek for reopening the case and for recalling the witnesses if there was sufficient justification given for their absence. The manner of how the matter will be dealt with has been set forth in the judgment of this Court in Santosh Kumar Berry Vs. Nirmala Devi and others, 2013 (1) PLR 404.

The petition is dismissed but the petitioner will have the remedy as set out in the aforesaid judgment.
