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**AMIT RAWAL, J. (Oral)**

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the revision petition with a liberty to file appropriate application under Order 22 Rule 10 of Code of Civil Procedure. He further submits that in case said application is filed, the trial Court shall decide the same in accordance with law and uninfluenced with the order passed in the application filed under Order 1 Rule 10.

Prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is fair, legal and justified as in these circumstances, the application under Order 1 Rule 10 of

Code of Civil Procedure was not maintainable.

The revision petition is disposed of in terms of the liberty sought and in case application under Order 22 Rule 10 is filed, the trial Court shall decide the same in accordance with law & shall decide such application, uninfluenced with the order passed in application filed under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC.
