Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has informed that the order passed under Section 7(2) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, was challenged by him in writ petition No.25329 of 2015.

The said writ petition was disposed of by giving liberty to the respondent to avail the statutory remedy of appeal within 15 days and in the meantime, *status quo* with regard to demolition was ordered to be maintained.

In view of the above said order, counsel for the respondent No.1 states that he will withdraw the suit and take his remedy of filing the appeal and this petition would then be rendered infructuous. So, in view of the submission made by learned counsel for respondent No.1 and the fact that the respondents will withdraw the suit, this petition is disposed of.
