Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 19.08.2015 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Dhuri, vide which the request made by the petitioner for consolidation of two suits titled as “Mohinder Singh vs Gurdev Singh” and “Gurdev Singh vs Mohinder Singh”, was declined.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that the suit titled as “Mohinder Singh vs Gurdev Singh” is at initial stage whereas the other suit titled as “Gurdev Singh vs Mohinder Singh” is at the rebuttal stage. The lower court has observed that the controversy between the parties is entirely different in both the cases and relief claimed is also not same. Therefore, though both the cases are being tried by the same court, there is no need to consolidate the same.

Accordingly, the present revision petition stands dismissed.
