This is a revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 07.07.2014 passed by Additional District Judge, Barnala thereby granting sum of Rs.10,500/- per month as maintenance along with litigation expenses of Rs.5,000/- to the respondents in proceedings under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act in a petition for divorce filed by the petitioner under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act.

During course of arguments, it transpires that the respondent is shouldering the responsibility of maintaining two minor children born out of the wedlock. The respondent No.1 has been awarded a sum of Rs.3,000/- per month only whereas the remaining amount of Rs.7,500/- is meant for the minor children born out of the wedlock. The amount of Rs.10,500/-, in view of said circumstances, does not appear to be on higher side but a bare minimum for survival of the respondents.

No ground is made out for interference in the order.

This petition is dismissed.
