Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

The only request in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the appellate court to decide the civil appeal dated 15.5.2013 which is now fixed for 15.2.2015.

Perusal of the zimni orders reveals that adjournments have been granted by Additional District Judge, Rohtak at the asking of learned counsel for the appellant time and again. In this regard, reference may be made to orders dated 11.9.2014 and 9.10.2014. It transpires that interim order is operating in favour of the appellants, respondents herein. It is apparently for this reason that the appellants are seeking adjournment after adjournment without any plausible reasons having been shown.

No notice is being issued to the respondents in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondents in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

Having heard Counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the appellate court is directed to decide the appeal expeditiously and preferably within a month and hear the arguments of the parties on the date fixed before it, i.e., 15.2.2015.
