The challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 21.10.2009 whereby the application filed by the petitioners-defendants for rendering the suit infructuous, in view of the stand taken by Gram Panchayat in the written statement, has been declined.

The revision was filed on 21.5.2009. There is no interim order with regard to the operation of the impugned order, much less this court while admitting the revision petition directed the trial court to continue the proceedings and make sincere efforts for expeditious disposal of the suit.

It is expected that by now the suit must have been disposed of. Even otherwise, the impugned order would have no effect. The relief sought by the petitioners-defendants by now must have been redressed in view of the written statement filed by the Gram Panchayat, at the initial stage, for rendering the suit as

infructuous.

In view of the aforementioned observations made, the revision petition is accordingly dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is granted to move appropriate application, if the suit is still pending.
