JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The husband is in revision aggrieved by the order dated 19.05.2014 (**P-1**), passed by the learned Family Court, Gurgaon, whereby maintenance *pendente lite* @ ₹ 15,000/- per month with effect from the date of filing of the application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act in the pending divorce petition initiated by the husband has been allowed.

This Court had issued notice *inter alia* for initiating the process of an amicable settlement.

On the last date of hearing, the parties were directed to come present for today.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent-wife states that the present revision has become infructuous since the petitioner-husband has already withdrawn his divorce petition.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner-husband states that he has no such instructions, however, in view of the fact that his client is not in touch with him, therefore, inference is that he may have withdrawn the divorce petition.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is disposed of as infructuous, however, liberty is granted to the petitioner-husband that if the aforesaid fact is not correct, he may seek revival of the present petition within eight weeks from today.
