1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not.
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the digest ?

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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the revisionists states that her (plaintiff No. 1) ex-parte evidence has been closed by orders by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amritsar, vide order dated 24.7.2014.

Learned counsel for revisionists states that the defendants are ex-parte before the lower Court and that the plaintiff/revisionist No. 1 wants to examine one ASI and bank official, for which she needs only one opportunity. It is stated that though 5/6 opportunities were availed, but these witnesses could not be examined.

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In view of the matter, the impugned order dated 24.7.2014, passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amritsar, is set aside and one more opportunity to the plaintiff/revisionist No. 1 is granted to examine the said witnesses at her own risk and responsibility, subject to deposit of costs of Rs. 2,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar.

The revision is accordingly allowed.
