Counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, when found that the Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter on merits, prays that four and a half months' time may be granted to the petitioner to vacate the premises.

In view of the above, this revision petition stands dismissed on merits. However, as per the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, four and a half months' time is granted to the petitioner to vacate the premises subject to his furnishing an undertaking in this regard before the Rent Controller, within a period of two weeks from today that he shall hand over the vacant possession of the demised premises to the respondents on or before 31.01.2016 and that he shall also pay the rent on or before 7th day of each calendar month. This would be further subject to payment of arrears of rent till date, if any due within two weeks.
