Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the defendants, petitioners herein, urges that inadvertently cross examination of Paramjit Kaur PW1 could not be effected by them, which has caused great prejudice to them.

No notice is being issued to the respondents in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondents in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

Since only one witness is to be cross examined and the defendants have a right in that respect, the impugned order is set aside; one opportunity is granted to the defendants to cross examine Paramjit Kaur PW1, who will be presented by the plaintiffs, subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/-, to be paid to the opposite party.

The petition stands disposed of.
