Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioners, impugning order dated 17.12.2014 (Annexure P-1), states that the petitioner-plaintiffs only want to tender jamabandi for the year 2008-09, which could not be tendered earlier as the same was not available with them. It is claimed that the said document is available with the plaintiffs now and the same would be tendered on the date fixed if such permission is granted.

No notice is being issued to the respondents in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondents in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

Since the plaintiffs have already closed the oral evidence, notwithstanding the opportunities taken earlier by the petitioner-plaintiffs, setting aside the impugned order, one more opportunity is granted to the petitioner-plaintiffs to tender certified copy of the said document subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/-, to be paid to the opposite party.

Admissibility, relevance and probative value of the document would of course be subject to discussion.
