1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not.
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the digest ?

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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The revisionist seeks rendition of accounts from the respondent No. 2-Punjab Agricultural Development Bank, from whom the loan was taken. The Assistant Registrar Co-operative Societies was also made party. The lower Court dismissed the suit. The appeal was dismissed on the ground that the jurisdiction of civil court is barred under Section 82 of the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act (in short 'the Act').

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Admittedly, in this case, no notice under Section 79 of the Act was given. It being so, the suit could not be filed. If the plaintiff/revisionist wanted rendition of accounts, he could have sought the information from respondent No. 2-Bank under the Right to Information Act, 2005, if the same is not supplied to him in routine. Moreover, he could seek appropriate remedy before the Assistant Registrar Co-operative Societies under the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act, 1961.

Learned counsel for the plaintiff/revisionist wishes to withdraw the present revision with liberty to avail appropriate remedy before the Assistant Registrar Co-operative Societies under the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act, 1961.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
