Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 09.07.2014
(Annexure P-4) passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kurukshetra,
whereby consequent upon the objections filed by Charanjit Kaur-respondent
No.2, execution of the judgment and decree dated 09.10.2012 passed in
favour of the petitioner, has been stayed and issues have been framed in the
execution petition.

filed a civil suit challenging the judgment and decree dated 09.10.2012.

During the pendency of this petition, the aforesaid suit filed by Charanjit Kaur-respondent No.2 has since been decreed vide judgment dated 02.11.2015 (Annexure R-6) and the earlier decree dated 09.10.2012 passed in Civil Suit No.361 of 2008 has been held to be null and void.

In view of the judgment and decree dated 02.11.2015 (Annexure R-6 and R-7) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kurukshetra in Civil Suit No.3876 of 2013, the present petition has become infructuous.
