Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 25.08.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Panipat, whereby application filed by the petitioners for completing the evidence of Ram Chander (PW-1) has been dismissed.

Plaintiffs-petitioners had examined Ram Chander as PW-1, who tendered his affidavit in examination-in-chief on 23.09.2011 and thereafter, failed to appear in the Court. Therefore, he could not be cross-examined despite availing more than 15 opportunities.

In the given circumstances of the case, to impart complete justice to the parties and also to avoid deprivation of full opportunity to the petitioner, this Court deems it appropriate to provide one last opportunity to the petitioners to complete the cross-examination of Ram Chander (PW-1).

In view of the above, the impugned order dated 25.08.2015 is set aside and one last opportunity is granted to the petitioners for cross-examination of Ram Chander (PW-1), subject to costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Service Authority, Panipat.

Allowed accordingly.
