Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 08.11.2013 passed by learned Addl. District Judge, Gurdaspur, vide which in an application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short 'the H.M. Act'), maintenance @ ₹5,000/- per month, was allowed to the wife pending the disposal of the petition filed by the husband under Section 13 of the H.M. Act.

It comes out that the petitioner in this case is a Head Constable in Punjab Police. The court assessed his income ₹50,000/- per month. Therefore, ₹5,000/- per month as maintenance to the wife is not excessive or exorbitant.

Therefore, there is no ground to interfere in the impugned order.

Accordingly, the present revision petition stands dismissed.
