This petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana, to decide the interim application (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner in a petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act for custody of minor Harshveer Singh.

Petitioner and respondent are husband and wife and their marriage was solemnized on 15.10.2000. Out of this wedlock, a male child namely Harshveer Singh was born on 05.09.2001. Due to difference in temperaments, relations between the petitioner and respondent became strained. Thereafter, respondent-wife started residing separately from the petitioner along with their minor child. Consequently, the petitioner filed a petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act (Annexure P-1) for custody of the minor child. Along with the said petition, he also filed an application (Annexure P-2) for grant of interim custody of the minor or allow him to meet the minor child in the Court on specific date and time during the pendency of the main petition. This application was filed on

27.01.2015 and after notice, reply has already been filed by the respondent.

Now, the said application is pending for 05.10.2015.

This petition, at this stage, is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to decide the interim application (Annexure P-2) expeditiously in accordance with law.
