Counsel for the petitioners has argued the case at length but when this Court was not inclined to interfere in the matter on merits, he, on instructions, stated that the petitioners would vacate the premises i.e. shop and hand over the vacant possession of the same to the respondent on or before 31.05.2016.

In view of the above, this revision petition stands dismissed on merits. However, as per the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, eight months time is granted to the petitioners to vacate the premises subject to their furnishing an undertaking in this regard before the Rent Controller within a period of two weeks from today that they shall hand over the vacant possession of the demised premises to the respondent on or before 31.05.2016 and that they shall also pay the rent on or before 7th day of each calendar month. This would be further subject to payment of arrears of rent till date, if any due, within a period of two weeks from today.
