1. In a summary suit for recovery of money, there had been a direction for furnishing security to the tune of ₹11 lakh. The direction came to be passed in Civil Revision No.1998 of 2010 and the security was to be furnished within 8 weeks' time. The court had given a direction that if the defendant failed to comply with the direction, the court will proceed to deliver the judgment in accordance with law.

2. Admittedly, the judgment has, in fact, not been passed. Before judgment, an application to extend the time for furnishing security was filed. The court has exercised its discretion and has allowed for such an extension on payment of ₹1,000/- as costs. I find no cause for interference. The civil revision is dismissed.
