This petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the Appellate Court to decide the stay application (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner along with the appeal.

Suit filed by him against respondent Nos. 1 and 2 has been dismissed by the trial Court vide judgment dated 27.05.2015 (Annexure P-1), whereas counter claim filed by defendant-respondent Nos. 1 and 2 has been accepted and three months' time has been granted to the petitioner to hand over vacant possession of excess area. Against the aforesaid judgment, the petitioner has filed an appeal along with stay application (Annexures P-2 and P-3). Precise grievance of the petitioner is that though, the Appellate Court has issued notice of motion in the appeal, but it had failed to pass any order in the stay application.

This petition, at this stage, is disposed of with a direction to the Appellate Court to decide the stay application (Annexure P-3) expeditiously in accordance with law.
