Impugned in the present revision petition is the judgment dated 20.08.2014 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), SAS Nagar (Mohali), vide which the application for amendment of written statement by the present petitioner under Order VI, Rule 17 CPC, was dismissed.

During the course of arguments, it has come out that the present petitioner had allotted a plot in the name of one Kirti Bhardwaj either singly or jointly with her husband Ajay Bhardwaj-plaintiff. Kirti Bhardwaj died on 02.10.2011 for which Ajay Bhardwaj was tried for an offence under Section 306 IPC and he has now been convicted and matter is pending in appeal before this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-defendant has stated that they are ready to transfer the plot or share thereof standing in the name of Kirti Bhardwaj in favour of her daughter Diya Bhardwaj (respondent No.2 herein) on payment of balance amount.

Learned counsel for the respondent-plaintiff has no objection to the same.

In view of the matter, it is ordered that the plot or share thereof standing in the name of Kirti Bhardwaj (deceased) shall be transferred in the name of respondent No.2-Diya Bhardwaj (minor) on the payment of balance amount, if any.

This order will dispose of the present revision petition. The suit pending before learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), SAS Nagar (Mohali) shall be disposed of in terms of said compromise.

The present revision petition is disposed of accordingly.
