As the Civil Revision No.5813 of 2015, against the order of eviction passed by the Rent Controller and affirmed by the Appellate Authority, against another tenant of an adjacent premises, is also listed for today, learned counsel for the respondent-landlord pointed out that since an appeal filed by the petitioner even in this case has since been dismissed by the Appellate Authority, this petition be also disposed of. Accordingly, the record was requisitioned. And, hearing of the petition is preponed and the matter is taken on board.

Counsel for the parties are ad-idem that the appeal preferred by the petitioners against the order of eviction has been dismissed. And as regards arrears of mesne profits from the date of passing of the order of eviction till the decision of the appeal, petitioner-tenant shall pay the mesne profits at the rate

of ₹5,000/- per month for the aforesaid period.

That being so, the impugned order dated 01.07.2014 is modified and the mesne profits are fixed at the rate of ₹5,000/- per month.

Petition is disposed of in above terms.
