The Election Tribunal, Amritsar has submitted the result of recounting of the votes in a sealed cover. The letter has been opened in the Court and it is found that the present petitioner has again secured 118 votes, whereas the other candidate has secured 117 votes. This would mean that the result of the Election would remain the same.

In view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the present petition.

The Election Tribunal, Amritsar is at liberty to declare the result accordingly and pass appropriate orders.

The present revision is dismissed as withdrawn.
