1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not.
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the digest ?

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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Impugned in the present revision is the order dated 23.9.2015 (Annexure-P-3), passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Abohar, vide which the evidence of the defendants/revisionists was closed by orders.

Learned counsel for the revisionists contends that it is a suit for recovery of Rs. 50 lacs. The defendants were granted five opportunities spreading over four months. The defendant-Surjit Singh was to be examined, as per undertaking given by the counsel for defendants No. 1 and 3, the case was fixed for evidence of defendant No. 1 for 23.9.2015, but he is an NRI and could not turn

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up due to illness of his mother. It is requested that heavy amount is involved in the suit. The defendant No. 1 may be given one opportunity to examine himself.

Keeping in view the involvement of heavy amount in the suit, one opportunity is granted to the defendant-Surjit Singh to examine himself, subject to the payment of Rs. 10,000/- as costs to be deposited with District Legal Aid Fund, Fazilka, without issuing notice to the opposite party.

The present revision is accordingly allowed.
