This is defendants' appeal against the concurrent findings recorded by learned Senior Sub Judge, Gurdaspur and learned District Judge, Gurdaspur dated 31.08.1984 and 09.05.1986 respectively, awarding the compensation to the tune of ₹1,08,000/- in favour of the plaintiffs-respondents on account of murder of Karamjit Singh, husband of plaintiff No.1 and father of plaintiff Nos.2, 3 and 10 and also for causing murder of Partap Singh, father of plaintiff Nos.4 to 7 and son of plaintiff Nos.8 and 9 on 10.05.1982.

None has appeared for the appellants today. In fact, none had appeared for the appellants on the last two dates and this is the third time, the case is taken up but again none has appeared for the appellants.

I have considered the case of the appellants and heard learned counsel for the respondents and have also carefully gone through the case file.

After going through the file and judgments of both the courts below, I am of the view that the lower court after considering the evidence led by both the parties, awarded the compensation. The findings were affirmed in appeal. The findings of facts have been recorded by both the courts below. No substantial question of law arises in the present appeal.

Hence, the present regular second appeal stands dismissed.
