Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present revision petition. The reason why he is not pressing the revision petition is apparent from the order dated 13.02.2015, which reads as under:-

“A perusal of the paperbook would go on to show that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 07.11.2012, an enquiry was conducted by the Addl.Civil Judge (Sr.Divn.) Guhla and a finding has been recorded that Shri J.S.Punia, Advocate, who was also arrayed as defendant No.3 in the Civil Suit, had unauthorizedly filed the written statement on behalf of defendant No.6, the present petitioner. Counsel for the petitioner prays for some time to seek instructions whether he wants to press the present revision petition, keeping in view the fact that defendant No.3/respondent

No.4 is his real brother and in view of the adverse report received against him, further action against him might be required. To come up for further consideration on 25.02.2015.”

It is to be noticed that the respondents have been adversely affected, since this Court on 07.11.2012 stayed the passing of the final order and the litigation could not come to an end due to the conduct of respondent No.4/defendant No.6 and the present petitioner who are real brothers.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is dismissed as not pressed, however, the respondent No.4 shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- as costs with the District Legal-Aid Service Authority, Kaithal for mis-using his authority and position as a counsel.

The trial Court shall ensure that the payment is made, before proceeding ahead.

With the abovesaid observations, the revision petition stands disposed of.
