The present revision was filed without annexing the order dated
5.10.2015 and this Court had passed the following order on 16.10.2015:-

“Mr. Nakul Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner-respondent No.1 before Election Tribunal submits, that despite having applied certified copy of order dated 05.10.2015, whereby SDM Zira exercising the power of Election Tribunal reported to have passed the order for recounting, has not been made available but this fact has surfaced only from the contents of letter dated 07.10.2015 (Annexure P-4) written to BDPO.

He further submits that after the aforementioned order, matter was listed for 15.10.2015 for recounting and with great difficulty the recounting process was stopped. Yesterday, the matter has been adjourned for Monday i.e. for 19.10.2015 and the aforementioned facts are being supported by an affidavit of the petitioner, which has been filed in the Court today.

Notice of motion for 16.11.2015 to respondent No.1 and 6.

In the meantime, recounting process shall remain stayed.

Liberty is granted to serve the aforementioned respondents through dasti process.

Today, Mr.Kanwarjit Singh Dhillon Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1.

Mr.Nakul Sharma, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-respondent No.1 before the Election Tribunal submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present revision with liberty to challenge the order dated 5.10.2015.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
