K. KANNAN, J. (Oral)

The revision is not competent. The order rejecting a plaint has the effect of a decree under Section 2 (2) of the Code of Civil Procedure. The remedy lies only in appeal and not in revision. The revision is dismissed and the petitioners are at liberty to approach the appellate court, if they so advised and if there is any delay in filing the appeal, they may file an application for condonation of delay in the manner contemplated under the law.
