Vide the order dated 29.09.2014, at the time of issuing notice of motion, the petitioner had undertaken to deposit a sum of ₹25,000/-. Said order reads as under:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have been married since 1994 and have two grown up boys who are staying with the petitioner. It is further submitted that efforts were made for conciliation at Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Gurgaon but were not successful. The petitioner is very keen to avail other chances for mediation. He does not press the present petition on merits qua awarding of ₹ 4500/- per month by the Family Court, Gurgaon and submits that an appropriate application will be filed before the said Court for modification of the order keeping in view the fact that a day earlier i.e. on 21.7.2014 a sum of ₹ 3000/- had been awarded by the Family Court at Ajmer in a petition filed by the respondent-wife. He further submits that for the purpose of litigation expenses, petitioner is willing and ready to deposit a sum of ₹ 25000/-.

On said deposit, notice of motion be issued to respondent for limited purpose as noticed above for 22.1.2015.”

Admittedly, the said amount has not been deposited.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he wishes to withdraw the present revision petition.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is dismissed as not pressed.
