SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the order dated 26.08.2014, whereby cross-examination of PW Ranjit Kaur was treated as Nil.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that only one opportunity be granted to the petitioner to enable him to cross-examine PW Ranjit Kaur, otherwise petitioner will suffer an irreparable loss.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on the other hand, has opposed the petition.

In the present case, the respondent has sought the ejectment of the petitioner from the premises in question. In case, petitioner is not allowed to cross-examine the respondent, he will suffer an irreparable loss.

Moreover, other side can be compensated with costs.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. Trial Court is directed to grant one opportunity to the petitioner to enable him to cross-examine, PW-Ranjit Kaur, subject to payment of ₹5,000/- as costs. Costs be disbursed to the respondent. Thereafter, trial Court shall proceed further with the case, in accordance with law.
