The petitioner had been granted ex-parte interim injunction vide order dated September 9, 2014 by Additional Civil Judge, (Senior Division), Mohali but on account of having not complied with the provisions of Order 39 Rule 3 CPC within statutory period, the interim order was vacated on September 18, 2014. The petitioner has got alternative remedy of filing an

appeal under Order 43 Rule 1 (r) CPC or could have approached the trial Court for extension of the interim injunction order explaining the circumstances for non-compliance by seeking enlargement of time under Section 148 CPC.

This petition is disposed of as not maintainable in order to enable the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy within a period of 15 days. The interim order dated October 9, 2014 granting interim relief to the petitioner by a Coordinate Bench of this Court will remain operative by next 15 days.
