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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Impugned in the present revision is the order dated 28.8.2015 (Annexure-P-3), passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Dasuya, vide which the application of the defendants for setting aside the ex-parte proceedings, was allowed and they were allowed to join the proceedings in the present case, subject to payment of Rs. 1,000/- as costs.

After hearing the learned counsel for the revisionist and going through the impugned order, I am of the view that the suit is for specific performance where the vital rights of the parties are

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involved. Therefore, interest of justice requires that the matter should be decided on merits. Therefore, there is no ground to interfere in the impugned order. Hence, the present revision is dismissed.
