Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 20.06.2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Sonapat, which was affirmed by learned Addl. District Judge, Sonapat vide order dated 10.09.2015 (Annexure P-3), whereby the lower court has refused to grant interim injunction to the present petitioner.

After going through the impugned orders, I am of the view that the lower court has properly exercised the jurisdiction and on the basis of the principle laid down regarding grant or refusal of the temporary injunction, the interim injunction has been rightly refused. Therefore, there is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned orders.
