Plaintiff is in revision against the concurrent findings returned by both the courts below whereby his application for temporary injunction under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 CPC for *inter alia* restraining the defendants from accepting land acquisition compensation of the suit land was dismissed by the learned Civil Judge(Sr. Divn.), Rohtak and duly affirmed vide order dated 12.08.2014 (P-7) of learned District Judge, Rohtak.

It is apparent that the plaintiff is basing his entire claim upon a judgment and decree dated 16.11.2010 the operation of which concededly has been stayed by this High Court in the pending regular second appeal.

At the time of arguments, learned Counsel for the petitioner states that his client is in judicial lock up and, therefore, want to bring certain documents which are required to be place on record for proper adjudication of the present revision. He thus prays for permission to

withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to file fresh one with better particulars.
