1. The revision is against the order determining provisional rent. There is an appeal remedy which is available to the petitioners and the revision will not be competent. The petitioners may therefore avail of appeal remedy and explain the bona fide prosecution before this court for condoning the delay in preferring the appeal by resort to Section 14 of the Limitation Act. Since there was already an order of stay, the petitioners will also be at liberty to seek for stay of proceedings before the appellate court and till such an order is passed, the petitioners will have the benefit of stay.

2. The civil revision is disposed of on the above terms.
