1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not.
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the digest ?

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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This revision has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the order dated 19.10.2015 (Annexure-P-3), passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Fatehabad, in which in the appeal filed by defendant No. 6 (respondent No. 1 herein), the judgment of the lower Court was not stayed and rather the official defendants were directed to comply with the judgment of the lower Court in re-drawing the merit list, but they will not dispense with the service of the appellant (revisionist herein) till the next date of hearing.

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The learned counsel for the revisionist contends that if the seniority list is re-drawn in terms of the judgment of the lower Court, the plaintiff/respondent No. 1 herein will be selected.

The perusal of the impugned order shows that the lower appellate Court has specifically directed that the merit list will be re-drawn, but the service of the revisionist shall not be dispensed with till the next date of hearing. The next date of hearing is stated to be fixed for today. In this way, the services of the revisionist have been protected. It being so, there is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned order. The revisionist can approach the lower Court for extension of the stay, protecting his services. If any adverse order is passed by the lower Court, the revisionist can always move this Court again.

The present revision is accordingly disposed of, with above-noted observations.
