There is no representation for the petitioner.

At the previous hearing, the argument placed was that the wife has received Rs. 3,00,000/- in full and final quit of the maintenance and was willing to get the marriage dissolved by mutual consent. However, this was disputed by the wife and on the directions of the Court, the respondent wife has produced the copy of the judgment of the matrimonial Court. The issue for consideration was whether the so-called compromise between the parties accepting Rs. 3,00,000/- for separate living and compromised as stated by the husband was not true. The Court has rejected such a plea and the petition for divorce filed by the husband has been dismissed.

The interim maintenance granted shall therefore operate to be reckoned till the date of judgment dismissing the suit and for any further claims of maintenance, the wife may resort to such action as it is legally competent.

The revision petition is dismissed with above observations.
