The petitioners have come up in revision for setting-aside the order dated 27.05.2015 (Annexure P-5), passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Gurdaspur, whereby the application of the petitioners/defendants for comparison of thumb-impression of defendant No.1 from some fingerprint expert, has been dismissed.

The petitioners/defendants have denied their signatures/thumb impressions on the documents exhibited by the respondent/plaintiff. The case is fixed for petitioners/defendants evidence and they shall have ample opportunities to lead evidence against the claim of the respondent/plaintiff.

The trial Court has rightly dismissed the application of

the petitioners/defendants for comparison of thumb-impression from some fingerprint expert.

No ground for interference is made out.
