There has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner since 1995. Efforts were made by the Court to get the appropriate address from the respondents considering the fact of the petitioner being a pensioner. At one time some address was supplied by the respondents but the office report indicated that she has left that particular house. Subsequently, the Court again directed the Advocate General office to provide her address which they have been unable to ascertain.

In the considered view of this Court that since the petitioner has not come present for the last more than two decades, I would deem it appropriate to dismiss the petition for want of prosecution but with the liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case any *lis* survives.
