TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J

The present petitioner joined service with the respondent department in the year 1989 having been appointed as Beldar on compassionate basis.

The instant writ petition was filed in the year 1994 praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner w.e.f. her initial date of joining as 3.1.1989.

During the course of hearing today, it has gone uncontroverted that during the pendency of the instant writ petition services of the petitioner have been regularized but w.e.f. February, 1996 by way of passing a speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further concedes that the order, whereby services of the petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. February, 1996 has not been assailed to the extent of seeking modification of the same so as to be granted the benefit of regularization on an ante dated basis.

Without there being a challenge to the subsequent order that has admittedly been passed by the respondent-department granting to the petitioner regularization w.e.f. February, 1996, the prayer in the instant petition seeking regularization w.e.f. 3.1.1989, cannot be gone into.

Writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
