The revision petition is at the instance of the person claiming to be a tenant. Counsel for the respondent states that the petitioner himself has given an affidavit which is duly attested by the Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar making reference to the civil revision filed by him and that he wants to have the case dismissed as withdrawn.

The affidavit also discloses that the property was in the possession of Smt. Savinder Kaur. The counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent states that there is a lease in favour of the Smt. Savinder Kaur, the wife of the petitioner, in respect of 7 kanals out of 52 kanals 7 marlas.

The affidavit drawn up by the petitioner is filed by the

counsel for the respondent. Both the parties agree that the affidavit contains some mistakes with reference to the property that is said to have been granted in lease to the petitioner's wife by the Wakf Board. The rights of the parties will stand readjusted in terms of the transaction in favour of the petitioner's wife. I direct to return the affidavit to the parties in view of some mistake alleged to have been made in the affidavit, but, the civil revision petition is disposed of as being withdrawn. This shall be subject to the observations made above.
