Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 29.02.2012 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Karnal, vide which the execution filed by the LRs of the Decree Holders, was dismissed. Also impugned the order dated 22.09.2014 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Karnal, vide which an application filed by the LRs of the Decree Holders under Sections 151 and 152 CPC, for correction of the said order, was dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have also carefully gone through the case file.

It comes out that the initial order of dismissing the execution was passed on 29.02.2012. An application under Sections 151 and 152 CPC was filed on 01.10.2013 i.e. after 1 year eight

months of the passing of initial order for correction of the clerical error in the said order. The said application was dismissed on 22.09.2014. The present petition was filed in April 2015 i.e. after about 3 years and 2 months of the passing of the initial order and after 7 months of the order passed under Sections 151 and 152 CPC, with a prayer to set aside the initial order i.e. 29.02.2012.

I am of the view that even though the revision is filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, but on account of inordinate delay in approaching this Court and on account of laches, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the impugned order.

Accordingly, the present revision petition stands dismissed.
