RITU BAHRI, J.

Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 30.10.2014 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rohtak, whereby evidence of the plaintiffs-petitioners has been closed by order.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that the plaintiffs-petitioners had availed more than five opportunities, including last opportunity, but they failed to conclude their evidence.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has informed the Court that the only evidence, which was to be led by the plaintiffs-petitioners, was to place on record two translated copies of the vernacular(s) from Urdu to Court language, for which, the witnesses were not available earlier. Moreover, in order to summon the above said witnesses, the petitioners had deposited the diet money and notice had been issued to the Patwari. The trial is at the final stage of arguments.

Keeping in view that the plaintiffs-petitioners want to place on record the translated copies of vernacular(s) from Urdu to Court language, this Court deems it appropriate to provide one last opportunity to the petitioners to prove the same.

Accordingly, the impugned order dated 30.10.2014 (Annexur P-6) is set aside and one effective opportunity is granted to the plaintiffs to place on record the aforesaid documents, subject to costs of Rs.2500/-, to be deposited with the District Legal Service Authority, Rohtak.

Allowed accordingly.
