1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment ?

Challenge in the present petition is to the impugned order dated 15.09.2015, whereby application filed u/s 152/153 CPC for clarification/correction in the sale certificate has been declined without assigning any reasons.

I have gone through the impugned order. Impugned order does not spell out any reasons. The same read thus:-

“Consideration heard. Perusal of case file reveals that present application i.e. under Sections 152/153 CPC for the correction of the sale certificate dated 18.04.2015 issued by this Court has been filed. Further, perusal of the case file it reveals that sale certificate was issued as per

record. In these circumstances, application of the applicant is hereby dismissed. File be consigned to the record room, Batala, for its compliance.”

The trial Court was enjoined upon obligation to give reasons that application seeking clarification in the Sale Certificate was not maintainable.

Keeping in view the aforementioned observation, impugned order is set aside.

The matter is remitted back to the trial Court to decide the application seeking clarification in the Sale Certificate dated 18.04.2015, in essence, application moved for clarification is restored to its original number and trial Court shall decide the same in accordance with law by giving reasons within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the aforesaid direction, the revision petition stands allowed.
